

Dear Neighbors,

This Sunday, June 30, Fort Lauderdale will host the Panthers Championship Parade and celebration, bringing a lot of excitement and activity to our community, especially on the barrier island and Fort Lauderdale Beach.

However, due to the influx of parade-goers, increased traffic and gridlock should be expected throughout the City and in the downtown area, where parking garages are expected to fill up quickly.

All residents, not just those near the beach, should expect an increase in traffic even if you do not plan to attend the parade. If you are planning to drive in these areas, please be prepared for significant delays.

Road closures on the barrier island will go into effect starting as early as 8:30 a.m. on Sunday, making it even more challenging to move around. While residents and local traffic will still have access to those areas, we strongly urge you to plan ahead and complete any regular Sunday activities, such as grocery shopping, by Saturday or wait until Monday.

We thank you for your patience as we celebrate the Florida Panthers' historic achievement. All eyes will be on Fort Lauderdale this weekend!

FROM THE NORTH:

Sunrise Boulevard, Federal Highway, and State Road A1A (north of Sunrise Boulevard) do not have any scheduled lane impacts, but drivers should expect heavy traffic as they approach downtown and the event site.

State Road A1A and the associated detour south of Sunrise Boulevard will be one lane in each direction all the way to SE 17th Street. Traffic will be heavily congested, and drivers should expect severe travel delays.

FROM DOWNTOWN:

The majority of downtown streets don't have any planned lane closures, but drivers should plan for heavy traffic. Downtown Fort Lauderdale will experience increased pedestrian activity, so drivers should proceed with caution.

East Las Olas Boulevard between SE 15th Ave and SE 25th Ave will be reduced to one eastbound lane for vehicular traffic. The second eastbound lane will be dedicated to pedestrian and bike users. Downtown parkers should plan on a lengthy walk to the event site or utilize the water taxi or ride-share services to get closer to the event. Ride-share services may be limited based on traffic conditions.

FROM THE SOUTH:

Federal Highway and SE 17th Street west of Eisenhower do not have any planned lane closures, but drivers should plan for heavy traffic. SE 17th Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction, starting at the 17th St. Causeway and heading north to Sunrise Boulevard.

Broward County Transit (BCT) Shuttle Service:

BCT Buses will run in a continuous loop to the event site from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and back to the parking facilities from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. The service will operate from the Broward Convention Center, which can be accessed from Eisenhower Drive. Bus service users should consider potential wait times and delays during high-demand periods.
